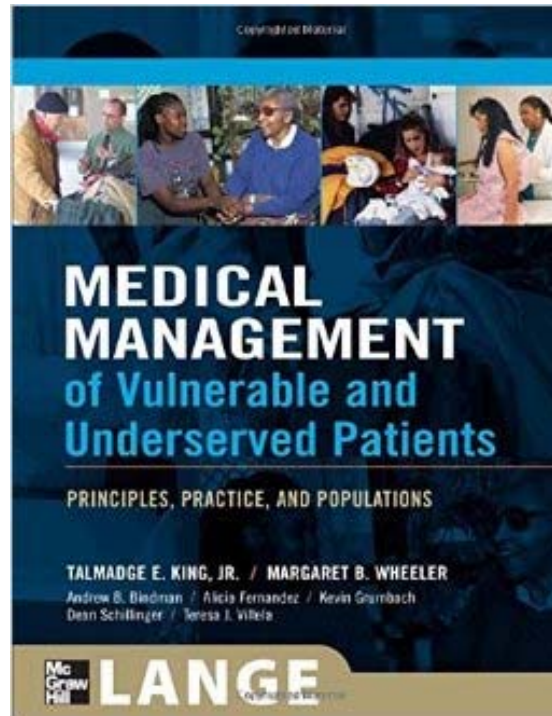
RESOLUTION

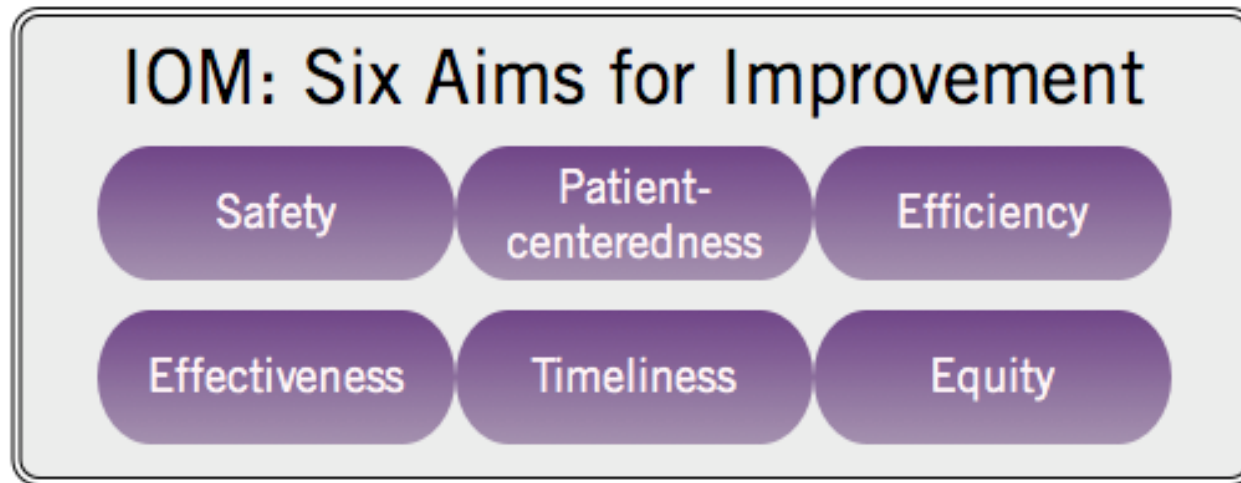

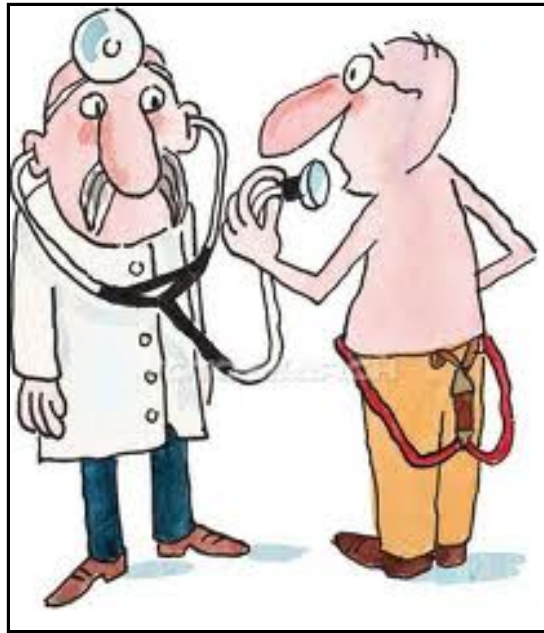

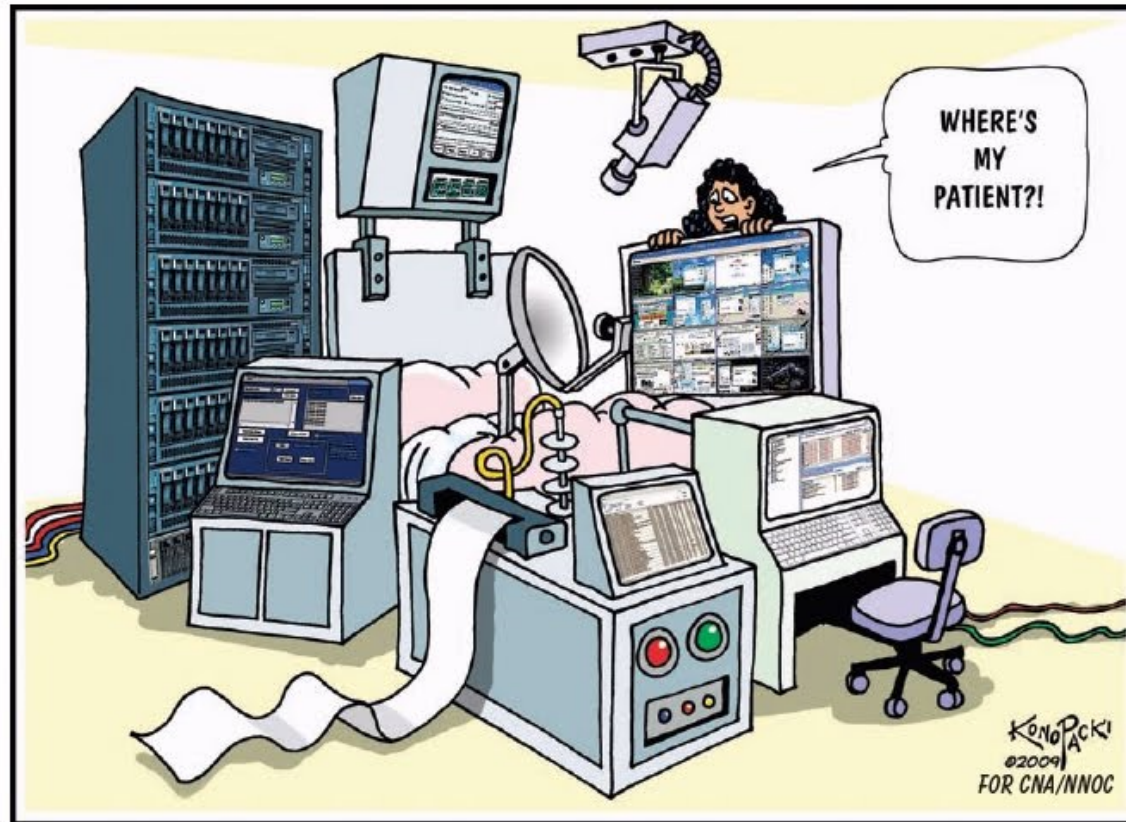
